

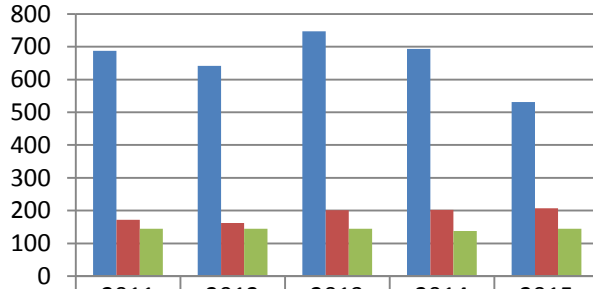

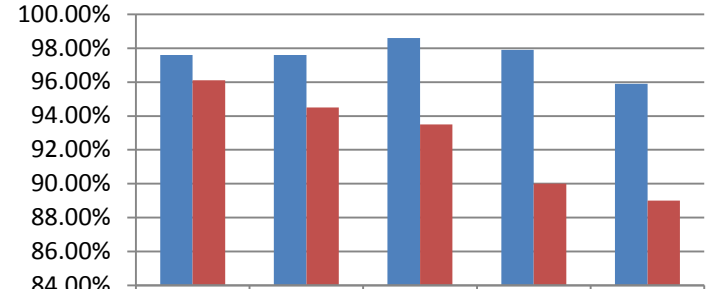


PharmD Enrollment Trend



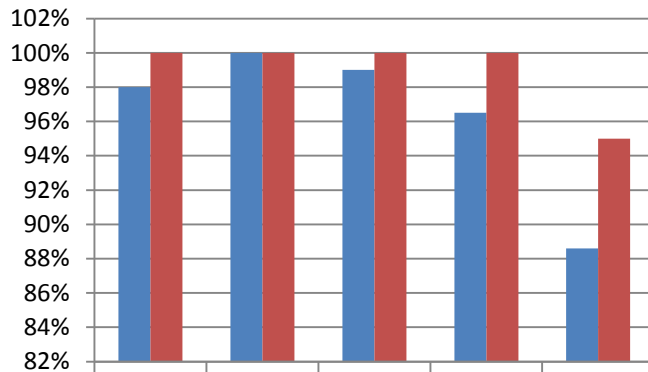

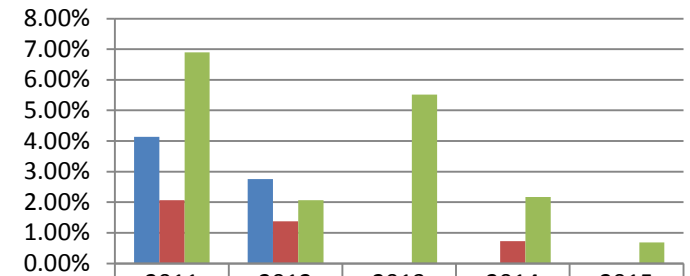

NAPLEX Pass Rates



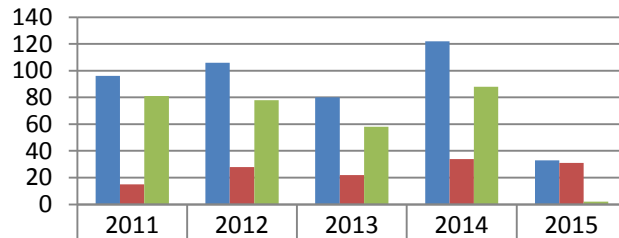

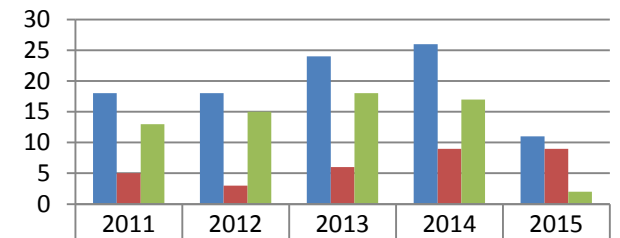

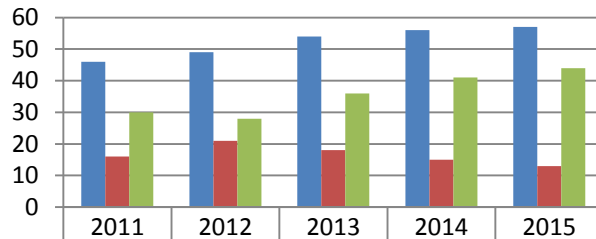

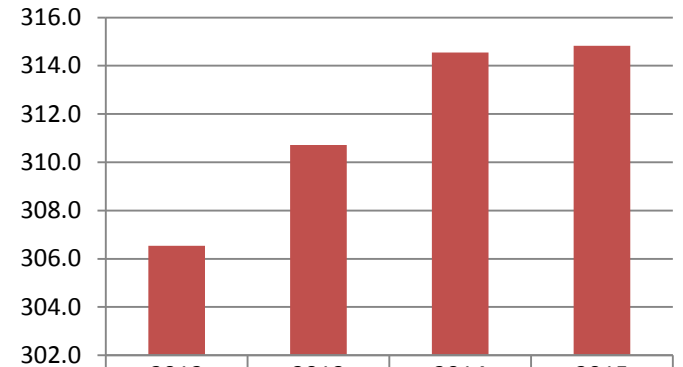

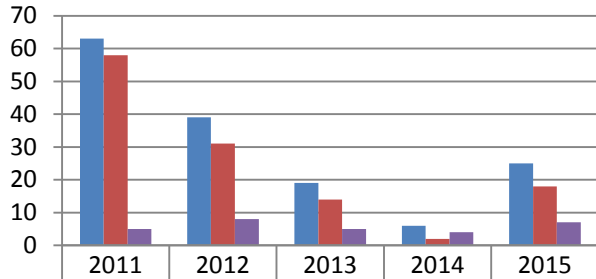

Average GRE Scores- Overall



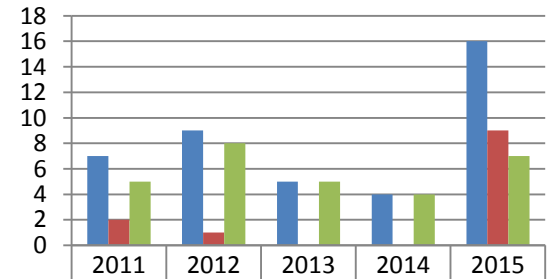

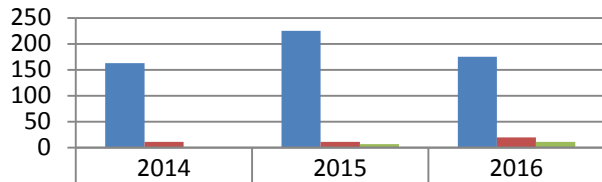

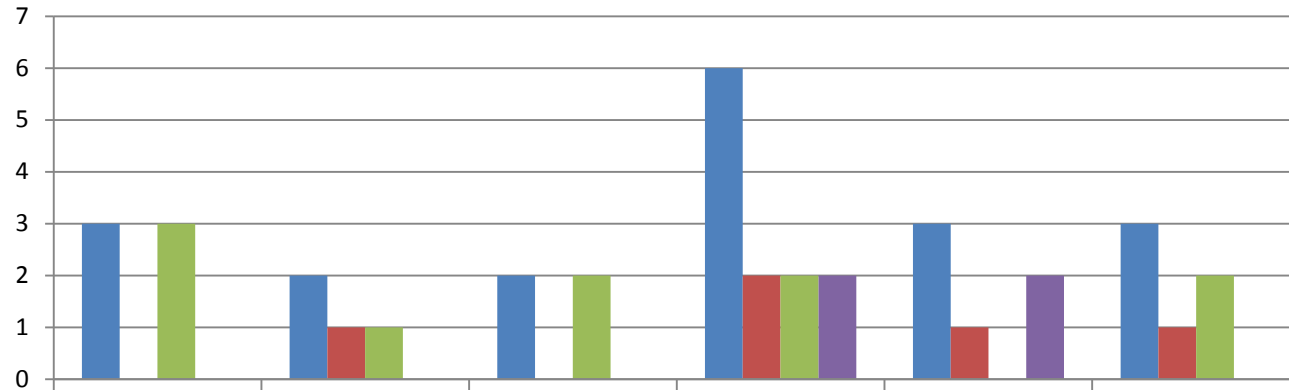

BS Program Enrollment Data



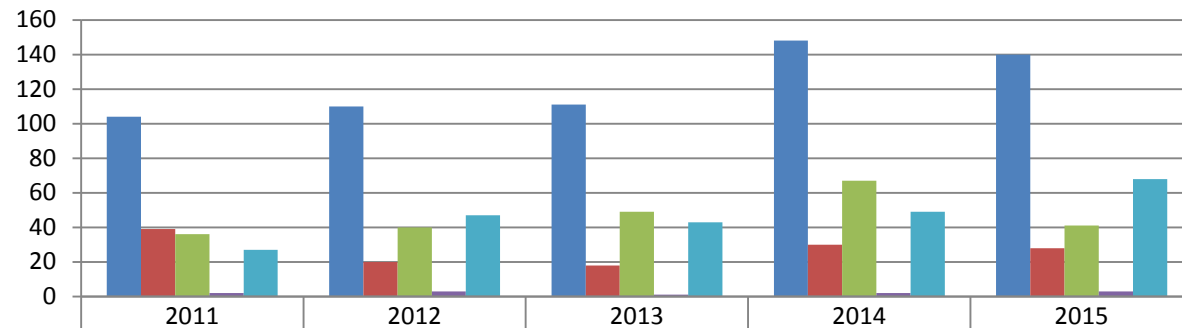

Successful Faculty Promotions by Unit



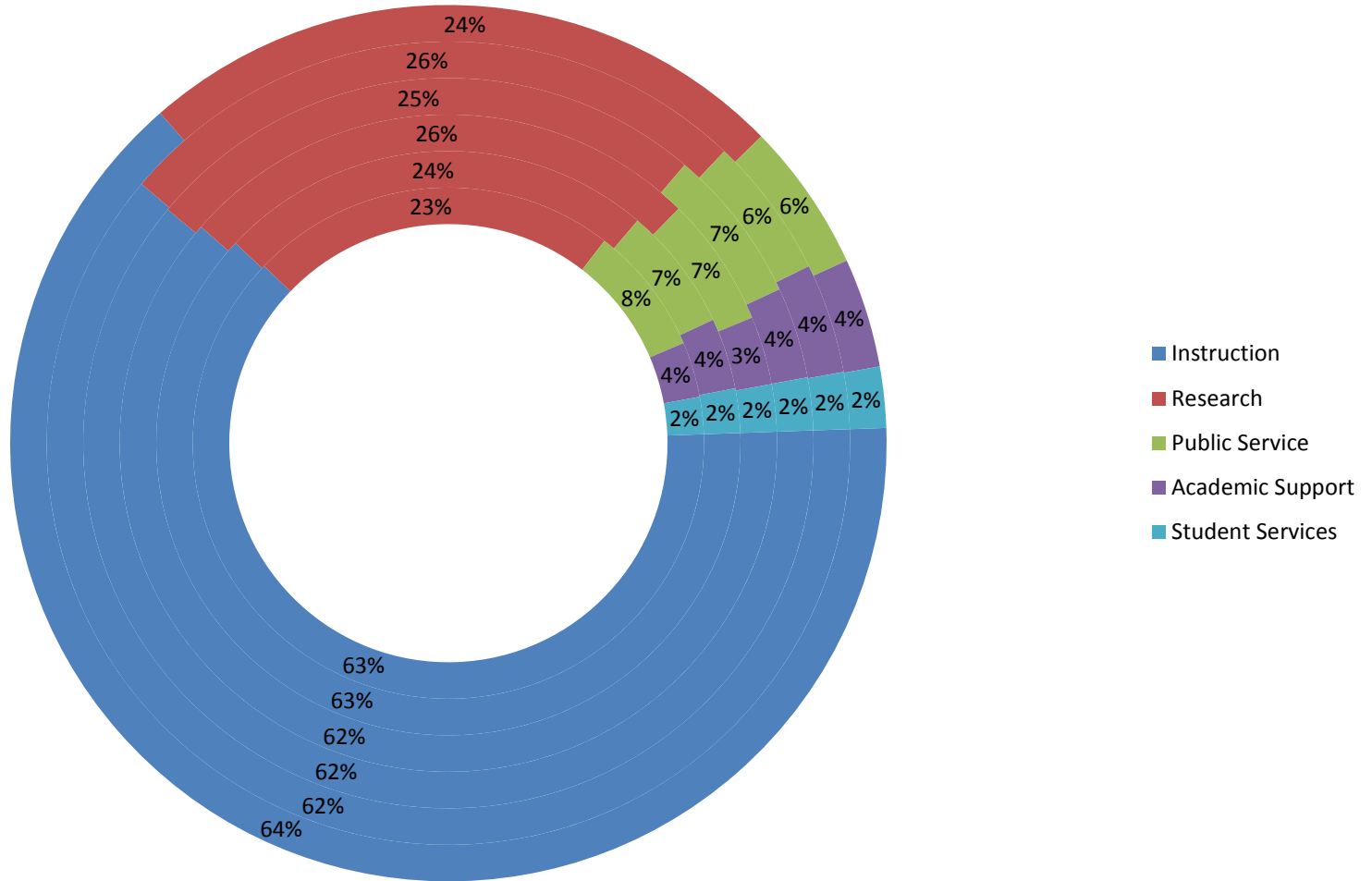

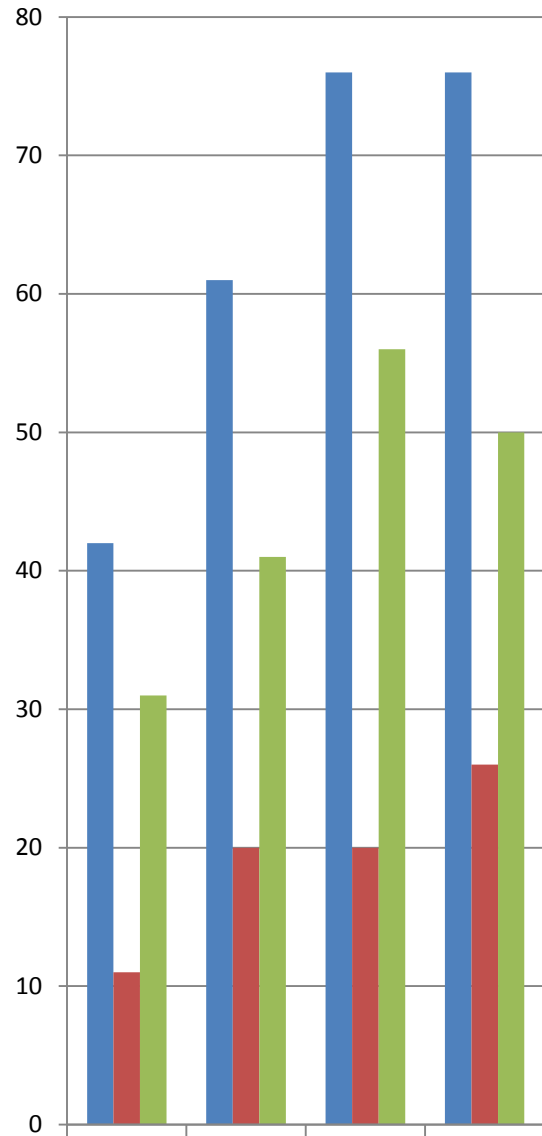

CoP Expenditures by Category 2010- 2015 (inner to outer)

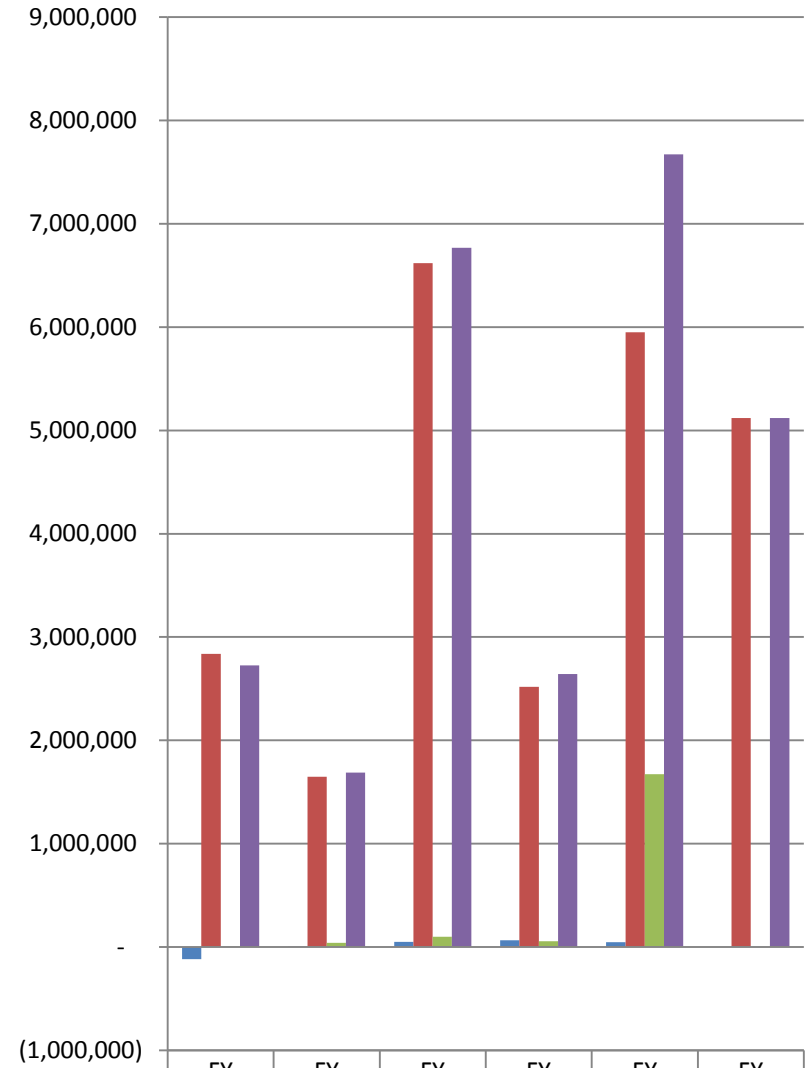

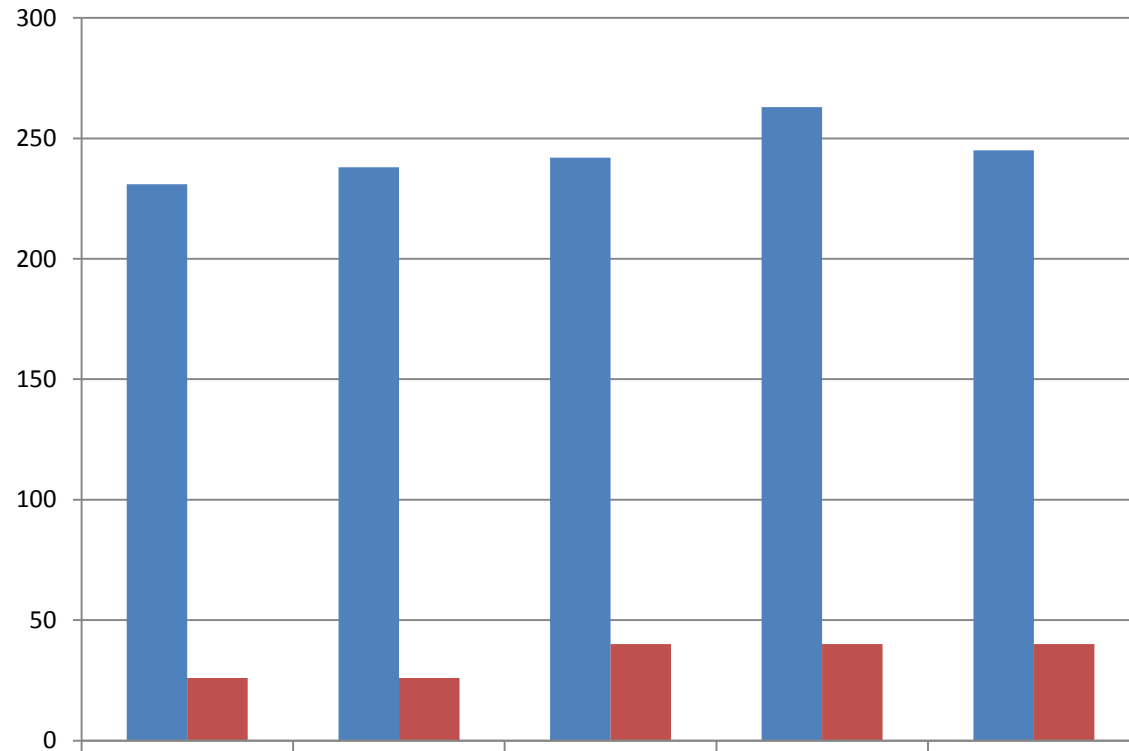
