Patients should bring their Pharmacy and Medical insurance cards. Those who self-pay will be billed and can conveniently pay online.

Health screenings such as blood pressure and blood sugar will also be performed. Student/faculty booths from student health groups across campus will provide information on hypertension, asthma, breast cancer, diabetes, fad diets, immunizations, sexually transmitted diseases, women's health topics, pediatric health topics, heartburn and more.

Dawgtoberfest is open to university students, faculty, and staff and families in the Athens community. All are invited to relax and enjoy the festivities on the lawn in front of the R.C. Wilson Pharmacy building, located at the center of campus next to Snelling Dining Commons. Parking is conveniently located in South Campus Deck.
