## Hemphill Receives STAR Award for Third Quarter 2015

Cicely Hemphill, an administrative associate II with the Dean's Office at the University of Georgia College of Pharmacy, has been named recipient of the College's STAR award for the third quarter of 2015. Criteria for selection was based on service, teamwork, attitude and reliability.

One faculty nominator stated that "Cicely was chosen because of her exemplary work in assisting in the organization of the faculty retreat in August 2015. She epitomized service to the department by working directly with faculty and staff to ensure all accommodations and any special needs to allow for minimal distraction and comfort for all at the retreat.
