Scholarships Support Pharmacy Student Education/Set Giving Record

Fourteen new scholarships were awarded to students at the University of Georgia College of Pharmacy in recent ceremonies. A total of 144 pharmacy and graduate students received 82 scholarships from designated funds, totaling a record \$229,750 in student support.
