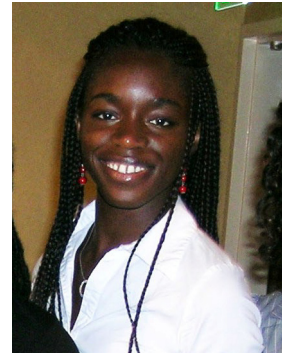
Pharmacy Student Receives Scholarship from Black Faculty and Staff Organization

Olubosola Oluyemi, a third year Doctor of Pharmacy student, is the recipient of the \$500 scholarship offered to a student enrolled in an undergraduate/professional program by the Black Faculty and Staff Organization (BFSO) at the University of Georgia.
